

Morgan County Middle School National Junior Honor Society Selection Procedure

Membership in the National Junior Honor Society is both an honor and a responsibility. Students selected for membership are expected to demonstrate the qualities of scholarship, service, leadership, citizenship, and character.

The selection procedure is determined by the Faculty Council of Morgan County Middle School and is published in the MCMS agenda and is posted on the MCMS website.

Membership is open to qualified second-semester sixth, seventh, and eighth graders. Candidates must have attended MCMS the equivalent of one semester.

Selection is based on the following:

1. Students' academic records will be reviewed to determine scholastic eligibility (a minimum of 94.0 cumulative grade point average).
2. Students who are eligible scholastically will be notified and asked to complete a Student Activity Information Form.
3. All faculty members will be requested to make comments on candidates using a Faculty Evaluation Sheet.
4. The five appointed members of the Faculty Council must make selections. The Council will review the Student Activity Information Form and the Faculty Evaluation Sheet to define the candidate's leadership, service, citizenship, and character.
5. Candidates receiving a majority vote of the Faculty Council will be inducted into the chapter each spring.
6. Students who are selected, and their parents, will be notified of their selection and given information regarding the upcoming induction ceremony and the obligations of membership in NJHS. All non-selected students will also be notified.

These procedures were developed in accordance with Article IX of the National Junior Honor Society Constitution (February 2005).
