



We strongly believe that our schools are an important and critical part of the Morgan County community, and we have worked diligently over the past few months to create a plan that would allow us the opportunity to re-open schools safely. In an effort to be transparent with our community stakeholders, we have added this “COVID-19 Updates and Resources” section to the district website. This will enable us to communicate important updates related to positive cases and exposures.

We are in regular communication with the Georgia Department of Health and our local medical professionals, and have developed a detailed plan to address positive cases and known exposures. The guidance that we are following indicates that anyone who has been in close contact (within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes) with someone who has tested positive must quarantine for 14-days. Students who stay home sick or under quarantine will be provided with remote learning opportunities and will have an opportunity to have their attendance recorded as digitally present.

Ultimately, we hold the health and safety of our students, staff, and community members as the highest priority and we will continue to monitor the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic. We encourage parents to monitor their child’s health daily for fever and symptoms of respiratory illness.
